POWER HAND/SKILL SAW SAFETY

1. Before using any power tool, inspect it to make sure the cord is not damaged in any way, that the ground pin is intact, and that the blade is sharp and undamaged.
2. Do not use the saw in a wet area and do not allow the cord to drag in water.
3. Keep your head and face out of the path of particles thrown out by the blade.
4. Always Wear eye protection.
5. Disconnect the power cord before cleaning, changing blades, or making any adjustments to the saw.
6. Never wedge, wire, or otherwise jam the guard to prevent it from working. This is a particularly dangerous practice that often results in dismemberment and even death.
7. Wait until the saw stops before lifting it from a cut.
8. Before setting the saw down, make sure the guard is closed, as the blade may still be turning.
9. Do not carry the saw with your fingers on the switch trigger.
10. Do not pull the saw backwards (toward your body) to make a cut if possible.
11. Use the proper blade for the type of cut to be made.
12. Do not use the cord to move or drag the saw.
13. Keep a firm and secure grip on the saw and the material being cut.
